We provide an induction program tailored for both online and brick-and-mortar teachers and special service providers. The program contains professional development and coursework, mentorship, observations, modeling, and overall support.

Program outcomes are designed to orient new and experienced educators with best-practice teaching strategies. Course work and support levels are determined by evaluating each individual's previous experiences and professional growth plans.
